
Here are the 26 improvements that have been made from the Fix-it House to the Safe House.






- The smoke detector batteries should be checked.
- The gun needs to be locked in a safe.
- The cord is frayed, posing a fire hazard.
- The cord could be tripped on.
- The grown-up needs to be more aware of what the kids are doing in the other parts of the house.
- If there are toddlers in the house, a safety gate is needed at the top of the stairs.
- A window guard is needed to make sure no one falls.

LIVINGROOM:

- A screen is needed in front of the fire place.
- Toys in front of the stairs are a tripping hazard.
- Jumping on furniture can lead to a serious fall.
- If a pet crawls into a small space, leave it alone.
- A safety gate is needed in front of the stairs.
- The "Safe House" has a carbon monoxide detector.



BATHROOM:

- Medicines need to be locked up high and away.
- Broken toys need to be repaired or thrown out.
- A hot curling iron can cause burns.
- A young child should not be near water alone.
- Bath water that is too hot can cause scald burns.

STAIRWAY & FRONT DOOR:

- Broken railings should be fixed
- Toys put away to prevent falls.
- Bikes and toys should be put away so no one falls.

KITCHEN:

- Emergency numbers should be posted by the phone.
- A fire extinguisher is needed by the stove.
- Children should cook only with a grown-up.
- Pot handles should be turned away from the front of the stove.
- Child safety latches should be on the cupboards if there are young children in the house.
